Holy Souls: During the month of November (the month of the Holy Souls), I will be offering all my Masses for your deceased relatives and friends.

THE END OF HUMAN HISTORY: In today's Gospel, Our Lord gives us a picture of the world in terms of the destruction of Jerusalem. It is a dark and harrowing picture. There have been many guesses as to when this time will be. People belonging to strange sects have climbed hilltops to await its coming in their conviction that the hour had come, swayed by some end-of-the-world prophecy of a false seer or fanatic. But Christ has told us: *But for that day or hour nobody knows it, neither the angels in Heaven, nor the Son; no one but the Father.*"

Coincidental with the end of things will be the universal judgement of mankind. When Our Lord appeared before the High Priest, Caiaphas, to be judged and condemned, the High Priest said to him "I adjure you by the living God that you tell us if you be the Christ, the Son of God." And Jesus answered: You have said it. Nevertheless, I say to you hereafter you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the power of God and coming in the clouds of heaven. Amid all the dark ruins of the world will shine forth the majesty and greatness of him to whom All power is given in heaven and on earth. At that hour the triumph of Christ will be complete. He who went through the darkness and pain of Calvary to a glorious resurrection will manifest his victory over evil. Just as from the ruins of the temple and Jerusalem, a new temple not made with hands and a glorious new Jerusalem would arise, so out of the world's end would come a far finer existence.
